












What is and what isn't included?

Find out how the costs of a funeral plan work, and discover what is fixed, what isn't, and whether there are any extras that you'll have to pay.

All funerals are made up of a variety of products and services that come together to form the funeral as a whole. This includes things such as the coffin, care of the body, and transport on the day. The majority of these are provided by, and carried out by, us (the Funeral Directors) and are included in all our pricing.

There are however, some aspects of a funeral that are carried out by, or provided by, third parties such as the Crematoria or Burial Grounds. We call the cost of these services 'Disbursements'.

The cost of any disbursements for your funeral could increase over time as the third parties change their fees. We guarantee that any money that you have set aside in your plan for disbursements will grow in line with the Trust's investments over the lifetime of the plan.

This gives you some protection against increasing disbursement costs.

Please note - Pricing of all of our funeral plans clearly indicates which aspect is a fixed Funeral Director cost, and which is a Disbursement cost using the coloured icons above.

Your funds are set aside in an independent trust.

The Peace Ethical Trust was established in 2022. The Trust holds and invests funds that a person has set aside for his or her funeral.

As such they are the first choice for all Peace Funerals plans.

Please note - The funds in your plan set aside for Disbursement costs (services not provided by us) grow in line with the Consumer Price Index (CPI) over the lifetime of your plan. If the actual cost of the disbursements has grown by more than this at the time that the funeral is carried out, then the difference would be payable by the person organising the funeral. When there is such a balance payable, and often there isn't one, it should be relatively small in terms of the overall cost of the funeral.

There is a £500 difference between the at-need price and the equivalent funeral plan price. This includes the £250 admin fee and an inflation cushion.

FAQ's

What happens if I die before I have fully paid for my funeral plan?

If you die before you have fully paid for your funeral plan, the amount that you have paid in, less the admin fee, will be available to go towards the cost of your chosen funeral.

Can I cancel a plan if it no longer meets my needs?

Yes. If you cancel within 30 days of taking out your funeral plan, you will get a full refund. If you cancel after that, you will get a full refund minus the plan admin fee (currently £250).

What is the Peace Ethical Trust and how is it linked to Peace Funerals?

Any organisation, like Peace Funerals, that provides funeral plans is required by law to make sure that their customers' monies have been set aside. One of the ways of doing this is to put the money into an independently managed Trust fund.

What happens to my plan money if Peace Funerals go out of business?

Because Peace Funerals doesn't hold your funeral plan money (it's held by the Peace Ethical Trust), in the unlikely event that Peace Funerals went out of business, your funds are unaffected and available to pay another funeral director to carry out your wishes.

Can the Peace Ethical Trust go out of business?

No. The Trust isn't a trading body – it just holds your money – and so cannot go out of business.
