

## Standardised Price List

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

Attended Funeral (Peace Funerals charges only)	£1,345
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.	
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£540
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care	£130
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at the funeral director's branch premises	£120
Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from oak or mahogany real wood veneer with handles, nameplate & cotton lining	£300
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer)	£5
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle	£250

### **Unattended Funeral**

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

## **Fees You Must Pay**

For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the **burial fee**.<sup>1</sup>

In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is:

£950 - £1355

For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.

For an Attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee.<sup>2</sup>

In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for local residents is:

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for one doctor to sign the Medical Certificate for Cremation.

# **Terms of Business**

For a cremation, a deposit of £1200 must be paid to Peace Funerals no later than 5 working days before the date of the funeral.

For a burial, a deposit of £2500 must be paid to Peace Funerals no later than 5 working days before the date of the funeral.

The remaining balance is payable within one calendar month of the date of the funeral. If an account has not been settled within one month, we reserve the right to levy an additional late settlement charge of £50.

If an account has not been settled within two months of the date of the funeral, we will levy an additional charge of 1.5% per month (cumulative) on any balance outstanding.
